Review and Approve Minutes from December 2024 Meeting:

- The SLT reviewed and approved the minutes from the December SLT Meeting.

School Culture and Climate Update:

- Principal Garcia provided the following updates regarding school culture and climate:
 - "Scanning School" Update:
 - Our incidents are going down so it is less likely that we will become a scanning school. As a reminder, scanning is only done for weapons, not phones or vapes.
 - A school Substance Misuse Committee has been created:
 - The committee meets every 2 weeks.
 - Some parents have joined meetings. We are looking for students to attend meetings as well.
 - We want to make sure that students are well supported in addressing issues related to vaping/substance misuse.
 - We want to be clear to students what the consequences of vaping/substance misuse are for our school.
 - We have a SAPIS counselor, Ms. Jasmine Smith, to help us in our efforts. Ms. Smith will be utilized in more severe cases.
 - Our goal is to have an action plan in place for this school year.
 - The next Substance Misuse Committee Meeting will take place Tuesday 1/14/25, from 3:15-3:45 pm.
 - Our Attendance Rate is currently at 84%. It was 85% before the Winter Recess.
 - We would like to leverage field trips as a way to incentivize students to attend school regularly.
 - We will be hosting a "Bring Your Parent to School Day" on 2/14/25.
 - We would like teachers to use the Word-Phrase Protocol in their classes to showcase to parents.
 - Mid-Year Assessments will be conducted through MAP Growth and exams in core content areas.
 - Senior Trip Fundraising:
 - Ms. Tejada and Ms. Reyes -
 - We have received 150 boxes of World's Greatest Chocolate (60 bars per box).
 - We are looking to begin the fundraiser by raising \$2000.
 - We will need adult chaperones.
 - Seniors have communicated that they would like to do something overnight. We need the support of teachers and all school community members to raise enough funds for the trip.
 - How can we get students to read more?
 - Ms. Reyes Importance of providing incentives for kids to read (anime, cookbooks, etc.)
